During this unusual time (COVID-19) our office will be closed, however, we will be working remotely and responding to all voicemails, text and emails. - SBA Staff

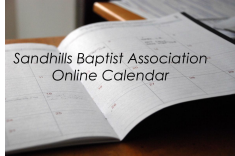
A Word of Encouragement
